Administrators Column

If you do not see it, remind them to sign up or renew their affiliation for 2005. Your insurance coverage depends on it.

We seem to be having more than the usual problems with the US Postal Service deliveries lately. Sometimes the renewal reminder postcards don't make it to all of the members two weeks before their memberships expire, as we plan. So that you aren't surprised by an expired membership, remember that the *Rev-Up* mailing label contains both your ROAR number and your membership expiration date. You can always renew early by using the application form on our website: www.roarracing.com, click on "Join". Renewing directly will also assure that your renewal will be processed promptly and you will have a membership card for future races. ■

Competition Director

David Lee

I have been on the job as Competition Director for three months as this is written. I have learned a lot and want to share with you a description of my responsibilities. The following is the statement of responsibilities that are written in the current ROAR bylaws: "The Competition Director will oversee standards of competition and will perform and oversee in general all duties incident to that office and such other duties as will be required by these Bylaws, or which will be assigned by the Executive Committee or the President, including, but not limited to, the

preparation of written standards for all levels of sanctioned competition."

Approximately three-quarters of those words are legal rumble jumble that means we need a lawyer to interpret what is going to be done. Since I wrote this on the computer using MSWord, the grammar portion of the software interacted indicating that paragraph also needs a language professor to build some understanding into it's prose. Now please don't take my analogy of that paragraph seriously and let me go further to identify what I am going to do for you. In other words that last comment was meant to be funny.

The first thing to recognize is that the Competition Director is responsible for the racing rules. That is a shorter way of identifying the "standards of competition." My predecessor took a large step with those standards last year by reorganizing the ROAR rulebook, and that is the document you have received with your 2005 membership. I must admit that I am still struggling with the new book, but that only relates to finding specific things in their new location. I think the structure of the new book is excellent and all of us will benefit from it for a long time.

I know that many of you have taken a direct and personal interest in this book, and I can appreciate that. Please understand that it is a living book of standards that will require updating on a regular basis. I ask you, the membership, to forward comments directly to me so that ROAR can continue to keep these standards up to date with the forms of competition that the membership desires. One example is to study the interest of adding 1/18 scale onroad and offroad competitions. We need rules for those vehicles before we can establish competitions.

The Bylaws also say that the Competition Director must perform duties assigned by the Executive Committee and the President. I received the assignment for the 1/18 scale rules at the last meeting. So, I am interested in talking with any of you about racing 1/18 scale vehicles and what the rules should look like.

The President has also assigned my position the responsibility to manage all of the ROAR National Championship events from the perspective of the ROAR Executive Committee. I have spent a lot of time with that for the last two and a half months, mostly learning what has been done previous to my assuming this position. Two of the scheduled national championship events will have been conducted as you read this. The first will be for carpet onroad classes and the second will be for carpet oval classes.

There was a problem related to the onroad event regarding the 19 turn motors to be used. ROAR had written a set of rules defining the 19 turn motor, but none of the manufacturers had submitted a 19 turn motor for ROAR approval. Therefore, it was decided that there would not be a handout 19 turn motor at this event and a method of inspecting those used at the event were developed. Please look at the ROAR website to see the standards and deviations written for this one time application. I want to extend a big thank you to the ROAR Technical Administrator, Bob Ingersoll, as we contributed equally to establish a method to handle this situation. This is an example of the members of the Executive Committee working together to make competition better for the members. We are continuing this teamwork by soliciting the motor manufacturers to submit some 19 turn motors for application in onroad and offroad competition.

Additionally, the Executive Committee has been reviewing the addition of brushless standards and those should now be available on the ROAR website. The position taken by vote in the Executive Committee was for the brushless motor/speed control systems to compete in the modified classes at the electric national championships in 2005. We should now have a good idea how that will work since those two national championships are completed and we have seen the results of combining brushless with brushed power systems. ■

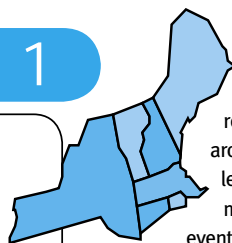

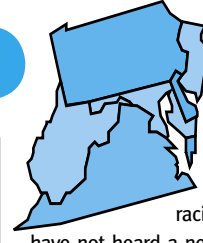

January Rev-Up Report (revised)

Therefore, Region 2 will have 2 Off-Road Directors available to monitor and enforce ROAR rules and regulations at all up-coming Regional Off-Road Events. More volunteers improve ROAR's representation and enhance the availability for members to voice their concerns and recommendations to improve racing in our region.

My goal for 2005 and this upcoming 2-year term will be a continuation of what I've already started. To improve ROAR's presence and ensure there exists a fair and consistent level of racing at all Regional, State Championships and High Profile events throughout our Region.

During the time since my last *Rev-Up* release there has not been a Regional event to report. However there have been a number of level 2 and club events to talk about. The following is a summary from Donald's latest e-mail, which I feel is worth mentioning: "I want to thank everyone that supported Roanoke Race Club this past year it was a lot of fun and some great racing. Now for the racing news if you have not heard a new indoor track has opened up near Martinsville. It is an off-road track located inside a warehouse the building size is 60' by 180' building. The track size is 110' by 50' plenty of room for pit areas and for the track. The building will have a hobby shop and food will be available. One side of the track has built pit tables for approximately 60 to 70 people with electrical at each station. The other side you could bring your own tables. Extension cord need for that side. It has a large driver stand. Amb Lap counting will be used no personal transponders as of yet. The location of the track is located just south of Rocky Mount on RT. 220, 34 miles from Roanoke Race Club track."

The 2005 Dirt Oval Regionals took place January 29th at Fastlane Hobby in Blue Springs, Missouri. I don't remember the last time our region had a dirt oval regional, so it was great to get this one on the books and turn it into another annual Region 8 event.

Fastlane Hobby is a full service RC race shop complete with an indoor carpet and dirt oval track and an outdoor asphalt track where the 2005 paved on-road regionals

will take place later this year. I knew when I pulled up the race was a success. The parking lot was full, and so were the pit tables inside.

It was quite a spectacle to see all the different kinds of cars being raced. It was like being inside of an RC museum, with gold tub RC10's and JrxPro's racing side by side with RC10B4's and XXX's, and in several cases outperforming the newer cars. One of the most interesting designs I spotted was a B4 buggy with its chassis cut in half down the center line with a pan car battery tray mounted to it so the battery could be placed as far left as possible. There were also many modern specially made for dirt oval designs, with Krenzel's and Custom Work's cars in abundance.

Three rounds of qualifying took place over the first part of the day. 54 entries filled up 12 heats with 7 different classes. Tim McDowell stood on top of the sprint division with 57 laps at 5 minutes flat. Chuck Kleinhagen TQ'd Truck Stock. Eric Wade battled all day, putting his car on the pole in the Sportsman class. Steve Matlick held off a very close field to front row his East Coast Modified car. Scott Betts had his Mod Truck on rails and avoided all the traffic to keep his pole position. Ron Harris had a rocket in the Late Model class, and Jason Halderman started the field off in the Mini class.

One of the cool things at the Dirt Oval regionals was the bump up. Denny Crooks and Rex Franke both finished in fourth place after bumping up from the A-main in their respective divisions. The other cool thing was the close racing that took place. Dirt Oval is tougher than it looks. Lap times were in the low to mid 4 second ranges, and when going that fast it is hard to react to crashes and cars. Keeping clear of the carnage was a key to success. Here are the full results. 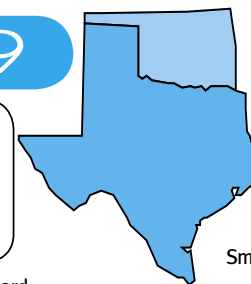

Jari Taskilla, yet another from Minnesota, made it look easy in Mod Touring, and JR Sangor took the pole in Micro, our little fast cars exhibition class.

After one more round of qualifying on Sunday, The mains were sorted out and head to head racing began. As the day rolled along a trend became apparent: almost all the top qualifiers won their classes after two mains. Stock Touring belonged to TQ Greg Amendola. He pulled away in each main and never looked back. Mitch Witteaman also drove away from the field in stock 12th scale, and got to watch Jari from the sidelines in the 3rd A-main. Bill Sydor led a Region 8 19-turn touring top three. He had to earn it, coming from behind in the first main to make a last turn tag on Nolan Waak, slipping by for the win. He walked away in the second main, leaving second and third up for grabs. Mitch Witteaman had a toehold on 12th scale for almost the entire weekend, but had to wait for the third A-main of 19-turn 12th scale before breaking open the bottle of champagne. Jari Taskilla and Mitch waded through the field during every main nose to tail. Swapping the first and second A-main win. Jari got into trouble early during the final main, and Mitch drove perfect. Jari Taskilla took the first two Modified Touring victories, avoiding what turned out to be a battle of attrition behind him. Mike Meartz finally got the region 8 he was looking for beating the micro TQ JR Sangor by less than a second. These guys were fast in micros. Their times would have put them in the middle of the pack in Stock Touring. The sportsman class almost belonged to TQ Cole Skiba, but trouble on the first lap caused a major mix up in the standings and Chris Short came out in one piece. 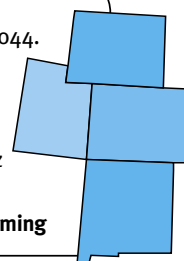

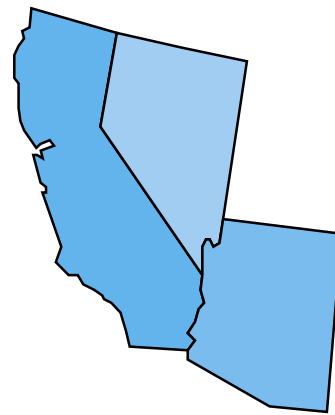

2005 ROAR RULES ADDITIONS, CLARIFICATIONS AND CORRECTIONS

The additions and changes listed below are being made to the printed 2005 ROAR Rulebook. A revised Rulebook, including these changes, is posted on our website www.ROARracing.com

8.4.1.6 Any motor found to be in deliberate violation of any specification will result in the OEM Importer/Manufacturer/Builder to have their products banned from any ROAR approval for a period of one year.

8.4.2.3 Can must have the original manufacturer's logo, name or mark.

8.4.3.3 Once passed by the laboratory, approval will be granted when proof is submitted that a minimum of 5,000 stock or super stock motors, or 2,000 modified motors have been produced and are available for sale in the USA and Canada.

8.5.4.4 Stock motors must be machine wound using a "Mabuchi" cross wrap technique, and must incorporate a design that locks the commutator to the armature stack so that the timing cannot be changed without disassembling the motor.

8.5.6.3 The Motor can must have inspection holes or slots between magnet tips so that the armature may be viewed for inspection of armature tag (see 8.5.6.4). These holes or slots may be no closer than .220" from the top or bottom edge of the motor can. The View through the inspection holes or slots must not be obstructed by anything covering the holes/slots (e.g. motor label).

8.7.4 SPECIAL RULES FOR THE MODIFIED TOURING CAR CLASS:

8.7.4.1 Rule removed - 10 turn limitations on TC Modified have been removed.

8.7.4.2 Rule removed - 10 turn limitations on TC Modified have been removed.

For Modified Electric Classes current rules will now include brushless with the following rules:

Modified Brushless ROAR Rules

8.7.5.1 GENERAL DEFINITION OF A BRUSHLESS MOTOR

8.7.5.1 Sensored or sensorless motors are allowed.

8.7.5.2 The motor has to be rebuildable. Ball bearings are allowed.

8.7.5.3 If the motor is sensored:

It must use a six position JST ZH connector model number ZHR-6 or equivalent connector with 6 JST part number SZH-002T-PO.5 26-28 awg contacts or equivalent.

Wire sequence must be as follows:

Pin #1- Black wire-ground potential

Pin #2- Orange wire-phase C

Pin #3- White wire-phase B

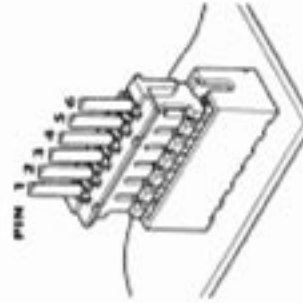
Pin #4- Green wire-phase A

Pin #5- Blue wire-temp control, 10 k Thermistor referenced to ground potential

Pin #6- Red wire - 5.0 volts +/- 10%

For clarification pin #1 is on the left hand side of the above connector with the wires exiting the top of the connector and the plastic tangs that hold the contacts in the housing are facing forward. See drawing below.

Compatible speed control must use the six position JST header part number X-6B-ZR-SMX-TK (where the X denotes the style of the header), or equivalent. The power connector has to be clearly marked A, B, C, on both speed control and motor.

A for phase A
B for phase B
C for phase C

8.7.5.4 * .05" size dimensions.

8.7.5.4 Overall maximum diameter is .3602mm measured at whatever point yields the maximum diameter, excluding solder tabs or lead wires. Overall minimum diameter is .3400mm measured at whatever point yields the minimum dimension, excluding solder tabs or lead wires. Maximum length is .5300mm measured from the mounting face of the motor to the furthest most point of the end bell, not including solder tabs, lead wires or original manufacturer's logo or name. Minimum length is .5000mm measured from the mounting face of the motor to the furthest most point of the end bell, not including solder tabs, lead wires or original manufacturer's logo or name. Motor mounting holes must be on 1.00- inch (25.40mm) centers.

8.7.5.4 Stack/Stator:

Stack minimum length 19.30mm, maximum 21.00mm. Stack inside diameter minimum 12.50mm, maximum 16.00mm. If a stack is used then it must be continuous. The laminations have to be one after the other without anything in between. The thickness of the stack plates is 0.35 +/- 0.05mm. All laminations must be of the same material.

8.7.5.4 Winding:

Only three slot (phase) "Y" wound stators are permitted. No delta wound stators allowed. Only circular (round) pure copper wire permitted. No turn limit.

8.7.5.4 Rotor:

Shaft diameter must be 0.125 inches (3.175mm). Only one piece, two pole bonded Neodymium or Ferrite magnetic rotors are permitted. Magnet minimum length 23.00mm, maximum 27.00mm. Magnet minimum diameter 12.00mm, maximum 15.50mm.

8.7.5.5 All motors must have the original manufacturer's logo or name moulded into the end bell.

8.7.5.6 A minimum of two thousand (2000) brushless motors must be available at the time of approval. A minimum of three hundred (300) brushless motors must have been sold to at least three (3) distributors or hobby shops or OEM's at the time of submittal. The manufacturer has to provide an address of a hobby shop or the like, that any driver who wishes to obtain these motors at the time of the approval can do so. No hybrid (mixing of parts from approved brushless motors) allowed.

8.7.5.7 The maximum retail price of a modified brushless motor shall be \$129.00

12.4.7.1 The following classes are defined as requiring hardout tires at Level 4 events: All electric Off-Road stock classes except Provisional or Demonstration classes

12.4.7.7 Additional tire purchases (Oval classes only):

In addition to the "free" set, drivers may purchase a maximum of two extra sets of tires for each vehicle entered. These sets may be purchased at any time from the beginning of the event.

Drivers are limited to a maximum of three sets of tires per vehicle entered. The minimum purchase allowed is one tire, as long as the driver is within his "number of sets" limit.

Drivers are required to run designated tire compound and stagger on specified location for the event. (i.e. if a blue standard is specified for the left front and a green right is specified for the right front, then you may not swap location of either tire.) Tires designated per entry must remain with that entry. (i.e. if you are entered in 1/10 19T and 1/10 stock then you must run your 19T tires only on your 19T chassis. Stock entry must have its designated set of tires, as well.) Drivers after being issued of one complete set of tires (4 initial tires per entry) may purchase one tire at a time up to two complete sets prior to the mains. Additional single or sets of tires for mains maybe purchased according to published rules.

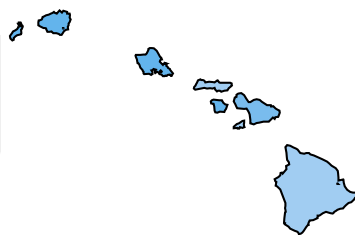

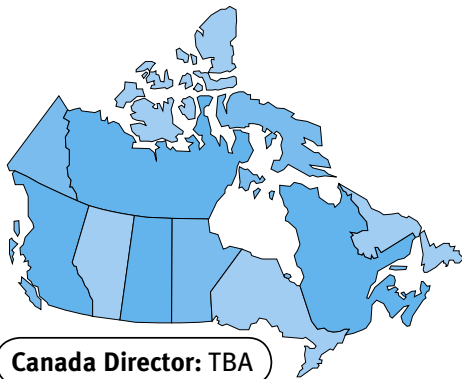
